

Workshop

Ecological project in North Devon

Eco English is a project based course designed for older students with a good level of English. It combines language learning with a programme that has an ecological theme. The course is based at the North Devon School of English in Barnstaple, the regional capital of North Devon. Barnstaple is a laid back and friendly town, surrounded by beautiful countryside with fantastic beaches nearby.

During the week English classes and workshop sessions are run by eco experts, which include some 'hands on' activities. They are combined with excursions that reflect the Eco English focus. Themes explored in the course include sustainable living, alternative energy and eco agricultural techniques such as permaculture. Students will be set a project to work on which they will present on the final day of the course.

Contents

Day 1

Arrival in Barnstaple and meet the host families.
Visit Stonehenge on the way from the airport if time permits.

Day 2

Full day excursion to "The Eden Project" and go on an extraordinary adventure on the rainforest aerial walkway or meet hundreds of magnificent free-flying butterflies: Learning outside the classroom pays off.

Day 3

Morning: Introductory classes.
Afternoon: Barnstaple town tour with a local guide

Day 4

Morning: Classes and introduction of project.
Afternoon: Eco workshop at Tapeley Park visiting Permaculture Garden & Straw bale house. This is a place where conservation and sustainable development go hand in hand.

Day 5

Morning: Classes.
Afternoon: Excursion to the sand dunes of Braunton Burrows (a UNESCO biosphere reserve) and seal spotting at Morthoe, both set in the beautiful naturally tranquil surrounds of a Nature Reserve (a UNESCO biosphere) with 5 miles of stunning golden sands at Saunton and Croyde.

Day 6

Morning and afternoon: Classes and classroom-based project

Day 7

Morning: Classes and presentations. Afternoon: free time or optional trip to fishing village Clovelly and Tintagel Castle on the Atlantic coast

Day 8

Departure and visit to Stonehenge if flight schedule permits
